

This policy covers the activities of the BGEN Penketh and St Helens manufacturing and assembly locations and identifies the key Environmental Management System (EMS) areas to be addressed.

The Penketh location designs, builds, tests, installs and commissions electrical and instrumentation systems including motor control centres (MCC), control panels, packaged sub stations, LV switchboards, systems integration of PLC, SCADA and DCS systems, AC and DC drive systems, Pump System Optimisation systems, Industrial Networks and Telemetry systems.

The St Helens location manufactures and fabricates pipework, general steelwork and modules for industry sectors that include: pharmaceutical, chemical, petrochemical, nuclear and utilities.

BGEN are committed to the preservation and improvement of the environment it operates in.

It is the BGEN EMS Policy to:

- Comply with environmental legislation and other requirements, such as approved codes of practice, that relate to the Company
- Apply an environmental management system based on the requirements of ISO 14001 for the manufacturing locations
